These two elevated berms offer the combination of high visibility and a full sun location near the entrance garden. Vivid spring interest is evident with early bulbs that later segway in to thousands of colorful annuals. Many of these seasonals are award-winners or new varieties that we are trialing. The plantings on these berms are arranged to allow maximum visibility of all plants from all sides of the berms. Grass paths separate the spaces and large obelisks create a focal point in the center of each garden area.

Garden Uses

- Spring bulb displays
- Summer annual displays (over 3,000 plants)
- Bold summer tropicals
- Specialty collections (alternate years)
- Holiday Lights Show displays

Current Needs

- Soil amendments
- Supplemental spring-blooming bulbs
- Edging repair/replacement
- Irrigation installation (6 heads)
